Road-End Marking Policy

The Leelanau County Road Commission (LCRC) has a number of County road ends that terminate at inland lakes, streams, at the ordinary high water mark of Lake Michigan and its navigable tributaries. These road ends are lawfully open to the public.

Upon request from a Township Board to delineate one or more of these road ends, it shall be the policy of the LCRC to procure and install markers to indicate the location of the right-of-way and the lawful terminus of such road ends.

It shall be the Township's responsibility to enlist the services of a Professional Surveyor licensed by the State of Michigan who shall identify and mark the location of the right-of-way and the lawful terminus of the road end, at the Township's sole expense. If the Surveyor's identification of these locations, or the sign markers are disturbed or vandalized, replacement of them shall be at the Township's sole expense.

This policy shall not preclude the LCRC from undertaking road end marking at its own expense if the LCRC deems it to be in their interest to do so.

The LCRC reserves the right to repeal or alter this policy at any time.
